We will be inspired and challenged to find and be the solutions we have been searching for.

1. Participants will examine stages of recovery from trauma and resources for recovery.
2. Participants will clarify their current and future goals for healing and transformation.
3. Participants will discuss useful resources for integration and transformation of life experiences.
